



Fontelunga

Cortona and Castiglion Fiorentino – Estimated driving time 30 mins

Leave the Villa car park turning right down the lane at the end of the lane turn right and go down the hill past the little church on right to a T junction. Turn right and follow this road past the Tamoil petrol station on the left and take the first turning on the left, signposted Castiglion Fiorentino and Brolio. Follow this road for approx 5mins up a hill and into and through Brolio. Pass over a railway bridge, a bend to the left, up another small hill following the road round to the right. Soon after this, there is a sharp left hand bend in the road you are on, sign posted Castiglion Fiorentino left. At this point to go to Cortona you have to go straight on, effectively turning right off this road.

If you would like to go to **Castiglion Fiorentino** follow the signs from this point. Park and reach the restaurant 'Muzzicone' entering the main gate of Castiglion Fiorentino and taking the first street on your left. You'll find the restaurant in the small square in front of you.

Continue along this road, onto the floor of the Valley for approx 5mins until you come to a "t" junction at which you turn left (again it looks like you are going straight on).

N.B. watch out for this junction when you come back to the villa as it is easy to miss! If you do miss it you will end up in Foiano.

You will, after a couple of mins, come to a small town called S. Caterina-Fratta. Continue through this village, passed the modern hospital on the left hand side and at the end, there is a sharp left hand bend sign posted Cortona. Continue along this road for another couple of minutes, past a z bend under the railway, and eventually you will come to a junction with the main road on the other side of the valley at the foot of the hill directly below Cortona. Turn left and after a few hundred meters you will come to another cross roads where you need to turn right. After approx 50 meters the road bends to the right then goes straight for 100 meters at which point you can you left or right and follow the roads up the hill to the town. Park in any of the parking areas out side the walls of the town (do not try to enter the town with the car as you are not allowed and if you do its is a nightmare to get out!) or near piazza Garibaldi. You will need to put money in pay and display meters up until 8.00 p.m.
